Linoleum Cut Block Printing Lesson Plan Kapa'a Middle School

Safety Procedures:

Students will be instructed on proper use of all cutting tools, bench hooks, linoleum, brayers, knives and mats before use. Students will be tested on their knowledge before materials are given. Students will be given a safety review daily.

Demonstration:

How to properly use a Bench hook
The proper use of carving tools
How to use, clean and store a brayer
How to ink a plate using a brayer
Carving techniques of linoleum – correcting linoleum when it is too hard/soft
Printing techniques – why prints are backwards
Registration – planning your print, how to register your plate

Vocabulary:

Bench hook, carving tools, brayer, ink, linoleum, woodblock, registration, pattern, composition, symmetrical, and edition

Skills:

Carving, inking, printing, registration, creating an edition
