**Unit Title:**

Mail Art

**Unit Goal:**

To have students create at least one interpretative piece to give away

**Lesson Title:**

Share the Wealth: Give-Away Art

**Lesson Goal:**

To have students create at least one 4" x 3" collage, drawing, low-relief sculpture, etc. based on the word "represent" for the purpose of giving it away to the faculty and staff of Kapaa Middle School

**Lesson Objectives:**

As a result of instruction students will be able to:

1. Learn about Ray Johnson, the New York Correspondence School, mail art, and give away art (*K-6: NS 4a-b, NS 5a and c, 9-12: NS 4a-c, NS 5a-d, NS 6b*)
2. Create one or more 4"x3" pieces, collage, painting, drawing, etc. based on the word "sky" (*K-6: NS 1a-d, 9-12: NS 1a-c*)
3. Create a composition that communicates an idea or feeling (*K-6: NS 2a-c, 9-12: NS 2a-c*)
4. Be considerate of their audience when creating their piece, who will pick their work and why, etc. (*K-6: NS 3a-b 9-12: NS 3c NS 5a-d, NS 5a and c, NS 6b*)

**Assessment Strategies:**

Participation, effort, craftsmanship, discussion

**Evaluation Criteria:**

1. Recall of information and facts, discussion of information
2. Create at least one piece
3. Composition to communicate an idea or feeling
4. Consideration of audience
